

SUPPLEMENTARY REGS EVENT DATE & LOCATION

Saturday 7th December 2019 Ngaruroro Raceway, Mere Road, Hastings.

PRACTICES

There will be 2 practices for each class. Each practice is to be a minimum of 6 minutes for the first rider.

QUALIFYING RACES

There will be a minimum of 1 qualifying race per event. The method to select the top riders is by timed qualifying over the qualifying session (not practice). Overall winner will be decided by points over two 10 minute races.

NO TRANSITION

Classes are determined as per race format. No transitioning i.e. riding up a class.

STARTING GATE NUMBERS

The number of competitors in any heats or finals is between 12 and 15.

QUALIFYING

The format of qualifying will be announced at riders briefing at the event. This will be dependent of the number of entries per class per event. This format may be different for each class at the event. All classes at the event will have a maximum of 12-15 competitors in heats and finals. All qualifying will be by electronic timing (mini's excluded unless entries determine otherwise) where the fastest rider determines a place in the final event. If there are more entries than the maximum start gate number, then at least 2 qualifying sessions must be run. All rider times are used for qualifying from a minimum of 4 full laps. The fastest 12 riders from both qualifying sessions feature in the main event. Peg draw for gate pick for the main event. Non-qualifiers move into support class if time permits.

PROMOTERS CHOICE

The organizers have the right to add one rider into any class final that have not qualified through the previous qualifying process

NON QUALIFIERS

Will compete in the appropriate Support Class. These classes will be limited to the number of start gates (12 riders). The riders that do not meet this requirement and are not reserve riders will take no further part in the meeting. There will be no entry refunds for not qualifying as the non-qualifying riders have had two practices and two qualifying races before being eliminated. Number of support classes dependant on entries and time.

RESERVES RIDERS

The championship and non-qualifiers classes can have 2 reserve riders. These are the next two riders that missed their respective top 12 to 15 final. These riders can line up at the same time as the main classes. If a rider does not make the start line in time, the organizers can draw a reserve rider in order of qualifying position to take a place on the start gate. The reserve riders are eligible to ride in their predetermined class.

NON QUALIFIER RACES

Will be combined with Support Class Racing.

STARTING BIKES

If as a result of stalling or crashing and a bike engine is dead the rider must get his bike to the side of the track and out of the way of the racing line prior to attempting to restart the bike.

FINAL STARTING NUMBERS

The organizers reserve the right to alter the final starters due to rider performance and or track size. Just finishing a practice and qualifying does not give automatic right to the championship final. As a guide the 115% rule will apply.

RACE FORMAT

- 10:45 Riders Briefing
- 11:00 am Practice session \ Qualifying
- 4:00 to 4.45 pm Track prep
- 5:00 pm 65cc on the line 5 laps
- 5.30 pm Rider parade 15 min
- 5:45 pm Night session starts including LCQ
- 8.30 pm Finish

TRANSPONDING/SCORING

Transponder timing will be used at the event for practice, qualifying and racing. HBMCC timing system will be used in qualifying, racing and results will be available when the race secretary has finalised the results. Transponders are compulsory for all riders.

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee will be

- \$65 per Senior\Junior rider
- \$25 per Mini rider
- \$30 Day licence (if required)

Transponders to be returned at the end of the event

- Supercross Open MX1 240cc 2 stroke to Open & 251cc 4 stroke to open 16yrs+
- Supercross Lite MX 2 250F and 126cc -239cc 2 stroke 15yrs+ ·
- Senior Lites 125cc only 14yrs+
- Junior Lites 125cc 12-16yrs
- Super Lites 85cc 2Stroke & up to 150cc 4 stroke 11-15yrs
- Mini Lites 65cc 7-11yrs
- Age on race day
- A maximum of 48 entries per class
